**PURPOSE** - The purpose of this outreach project is to provide high quality entertainment at a price (\$7) that is accessible to people in our greater community.

**STRUCTURE** - Each season we present five coffeehouses with varied entertainment. In general, the types of music programs we have are:

- Singer/Songwriter or Solo performer
- American roots music (e.g. old time country music, bluegrass, blues, Cajun)
- Jazz
- Music from other countries or cultures (e.g. South American, Celtic, Eastern European)
- Classical
- Contemporary Themes

**WHO BENEFITS** - Some money we receive goes to pay the performers and the rest goes to the Charity of the Evening and to pay our expenses (posters, mailings, food purchases, piano tuning, etc). At the end of our season, Gwynedd Friends Coffeehouse has no net profits.
